## Club182

Club182 is an enrichment club program set up by the members of LifeSpring Covenant Church to bless the students of Sarah Milner as well as children who attend the church. These clubs are led by members of our church and will provide enriching experiences in a variety of subject areas. As a result of financial support from LifeSpring Covenant Church we are very pleased to present so many excellent clubs for just \$5.00 a child.

Enrollment in each of the clubs is limited, and will be on a “first come, first serve” basis so return the registration form to your teacher or to the LifeSpring office as soon as possible. Students will be placed in only one club.

### Club Requirements

- Registrations must be completed and returned to Sarah Milner by Friday, March 26 or LifeSpring Covenant Church by Sunday, March 28.
- Students select top three choices of clubs that they are interested in.  
**If your child only selects only one club we cannot guarantee they will be placed in a club, as slots are limited.**
- Parents are required to pick up students at 4:30pm at the south entrance of the church, unless another form of transportation home has been agreed upon.
- Students are expected to use “school appropriate” behavior while participating in Club182.
- Club confirmation will be sent home with your child on Monday, April 5.
- Clubs will run after school on Wednesdays from April 7 through May 12. They will start at 3:00pm and end at 4:30pm...OPEN GYM is not being offered, so please wait until 3:00 to arrive.
- Club182 is for students in grades K-5.
- The Club182 schedule will run in this way:
  - 3:00-3:20-A fun festive whole group gathering where students will sing worship songs and learn about God’s love for them.
  - 3:20-3:30-Snack time
  - 3:30-4:30-Students will break into small enrichment clubs.

We are excited about this opportunity. It is our desire to bless the community that we are located in. We hope that you and your child/children find this experience joyful.

### Volleyball Club

Grades: 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

Volleyball is an exciting sport that requires bumping and hitting the ball across the net to the other team. Players will learn VB skills, will get to move almost constantly, and have lots of “hard hitting” fun.

### Rocket Building Club

Grades: 2<sup>nd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup>

We will be doing a lot of rocket building. And to top it off we will launch all of our rockets high into the air using a custom-built rocket launcher. The rocket launcher that we will be using forces air through a series of pipes, when the air hits the rocket it launches up and away. We will experiment with other types of rockets, too...sure to be fun for all.

### Eating Creations

Grades Kindergarten-3<sup>rd</sup>

Everyone loves to eat and create. When you mix them together you come up with a bundle of fun. Imagine eating a snack off of a rope, an erupting volcano, a giant germ, a ball or worms right out of the dirt. This club requires the skill of having fun with a hearty appetite.

### Speed Stacks

Grades: 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

Come join us for a fun time learning Speed Stacks! Speed Stacks is an exciting sport where kids will learn to stack and unstack specially designed cups in a specific pattern. It is super fun to learn and to compete against the clock to see how fast you can get! We will play all sorts of fun games in addition to learning this awesome sport.

### Wacky Science Club

Grades: 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

How can you power a light bulb with fruit? Want to create a magical milk color wheel work of art? The budding young scientists in this club will conduct experiments and record observations as they answer those “Why and What if” questions that never seem to end.

### Mind Benders

Grades: 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

Stir your mental juices with us in our Mind Benders club. We will have fun doing individual and group challenges that use everyday items to design, construct, and develop solutions to creative problems. Come prepared with your imagination and willingness to explore.

### "Spring Fever" Crafts and Stories

Grades: Kindergarten-2<sup>nd</sup>

Are you longing for warmer weather? These spring-inspired art projects will take you there! We will create crafts centered around themes of bunnies, frogs, bugs, butterflies, flowers, and Mother's Day. Fun stories and cute crafts are sure to motivate us to switch the season to spring!

### Scrapbooking Club

Grades: 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

Scrapbooking is a great way to preserve your memories. In this club we will be taking your personal pictures, and creating scrapbook pages all about your life. The best part is that each child in this club will get to keep their scrapbook, even after the club is over. All children in this club will need to come on the first day of Club182 with 20-30 photos ready to scrapbook.

### Play Ball

Grades: kindergarten-2<sup>nd</sup>

Do you love to play ball? Flag football, softball, soccer, basketball, and more...in this club we will get out and play some ball. The balls will be flying, bouncing, and rolling each week as we get out and play. Playing ball is a great way to hang out with friends, work on your skills, get your heart rate up, and just plain have fun.

### Origami

Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

Hopping frogs, flying stars, candy boxes and more. At Origami you'll learn how to transform flat squares of paper into amazing and useful objects. From the Japanese words "Oru" meaning "to fold" and "kami" meaning "paper," origami is the art of folding paper into imaginative and creative projects. This club is open to beginners and experience origami folders from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>

In the Airplane club we will be making tons of different types of airplanes, including more paper airplanes than you have ever imagined.
